CAN I GRADUATE???

YOU NEED:

- 30 credits (18 compulsory, 12 elective)
- 40 hours of community service
- pass the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test or course



CAN I APPLY TO SCHOOL?

UNIVERSITY:

- you need six (6) Gr. 12 university or university/ college courses

COLLEGE:

- a high school diploma with ENG4C plus pre-requisites

CAN I BECOME AN APPRENTICE?



APPRENTICESHIPS which one works for you?

- FOR MOST TRADES, YOU NEED A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA TO BECOME A REGISTERED APPRENTICE.
- (Grade 12 Math is **strongly** recommended)

WHAT IS AN APPRENTICE?

An apprentice is someone who learns a skilled trade on the job, under the direction of more experienced workers. Apprentices also complete classroom instruction as a part of their training. Apprentices are employees, and earn a salary while they learn a skilled trade.

UNIVERSITY TERMINOLOGY

Bachelor Degree

- three or four (Honours) years

Masters Degree

- completed AFTER an Honours degree

Doctorate (Ph.D)

- completed AFTER a Masters degree



COLLEGE TERMINOLOGY

Certificate -

- 1 year or less of study; skill specific

Diploma

- 2 years of study

Advanced Diploma

- 3 years of study



APPRENTICESHIP TERMINOLOGY

Journey person

- a person who has completed an apprenticeship

Apprentice -

- a trainee learning a skilled trade working directly with a journey person

Red Seal -

- allows an apprentice to work in any province

OYAP

- Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program

WHEN DO I APPLY?

- university and college application sites open in early November
- **UNIVERSITY APPS** - due January 12, 2023
- **COLLEGE APPS** - due February 1, 2023
- APPRENTICESHIPS** - ongoing

DEADLINE

HOW MUCH IS IT TO APPLY?

UNIVERSITY

- \$156 for 3 program choices
- \$50 for each additional choice

COLLEGE

- \$110 for five program choices only
- three can be at the same school



THE GREAT BIG WORLD

- students applying to schools outside of Ontario will do so on the school's website and pay a separate fee
- students interested in going to the USA must create an account on www.collegeboard.org and write the SAT and/or the PSAT

THE MILITARY

- students can complete their education and have it paid for by being a part of the military

- **there is a 4 credit Military Coop beginning in February - interested students can see Ms. Coccimiglio - deadline to apply is Oct 31**
